Oral presentation

1. How will the oral presentations be held?

*The oral presentations will be held on the [Zoom meeting platform](#). Each presenter will have **10 minutes** for a LIVE presentation and **5 minutes** for Q&A.*

2. I am an oral presenter. What should I prepare?

*Please prepare your presentation slides and send the ppt/pptx file to us **before December 14th, 2022**. You are free to use other presentation formats such as Keynote or Prezi, but we will need to have your file in PowerPoint format.*

3. Why does the organizer need our PowerPoint file? Can't we just show the file directly from our device during the meeting?

***You** will do a LIVE presentation and show the file from your device (please ensure your device (PC/gadget) is capable of screen sharing). We just need your file as a backup in case a technical problem occurs.*

4. Can I send a prerecorded presentation for the organizer to play?

***We strongly encourage all oral presenters to do a live presentation.** If you cannot make it, please let us know as soon as possible.*

Poster presentation

1. How will the poster presentations be held?

The poster presentation will be held as **1-minute flash talk** in the [main presentation room on Zoom](#), followed by a chat-based discussion on [Slack](#).

2. I am a poster presenter. What should I prepare?

You will need to prepare the following:

- 1-minute flash talk
- Your poster in pdf format

3. What is Slack?

Slack is a web-based message platform that allows you to chat with several people at the same time.

4. How does it work?

We will interact in a "Workspace" called "ISSS Annual Conference 2022". Inside the workspace, each poster will have a separate chat room (i.e., channel) where you can have a chat with the presenter and other people within the channel. In each channel, you will also find a link to the poster file.
